

Teacher Subject Specialism Training in Mathematics

ABOUT THE COURSE

Is TSST for me?

- A course to improve the maths subject knowledge of non-specialist teachers by offering school-led teacher subject specialism training. This includes those who could potentially teach maths in addition to their main subject together with those who want to retrain as maths teachers.
- A course that provides greater support to teachers wishing to return to the profession through access to subject specialism training.

Mathematical content:

Four modules are covered: Number; Algebra; Shape, Space and Measure; Handling Data. Sessions include both maths content and 'pedagogical content knowledge'.

Delivery:

The training will be prolonged and extensive from September 2018 to June 2019. It will be delivered at a number of Outstanding hubs.

The course offers a 'blended learning experience' of:

- 15 face to face twilight sessions of high quality instruction, facilitated by outstanding maths teachers/SLEs/Lead Practitioners.
- Comprehensive e-learning provided by the 'Centre for Innovation in Mathematics Teaching' at Plymouth University with Masters' Level Credits worth £910.

Please note, to successfully complete the course, there is a minimum requirement for all participants to attend at least 12 of the 15 sessions and to pass all online tests.
